Rescuing Abandoned Children

The Hope Centre was started by Pastor Lucky and Fikile Langa. She had a handicapped child from a previous relationship. The man deserted her leaving her alone with her child; she was not a Christian at the time. When she tried to find a place for her child, nobody was willing to consider her, and the places for accommodating such children were not available.

Fikile met other mothers who were also seeking a place for their children. These mothers could not find jobs because there was nobody to care for their disabled children. When Fikile met Pastor Lucky, he was indeed a godsend. He had a heart of compassion and willingly sold his preaching tent to buy an old, run down, school building. They converted it into a centre to house handicapped children.

The number grew from one to five children, and now thirty-three children live there; most of the children are orphans. The Hope Centre is now called upon by hospitals to pick up children who are dumped in trash bins or found in toilets. Many of them come to the centre bleeding, abused, or raped. The oldest is thirty-three and has been raped multiple times. Almost all of them cannot speak and use diapers.

Lucky and Fikile love these kids so much. They do not have any steady income and run their ministry by faith. God has been good to them these three years and has sustained them.
